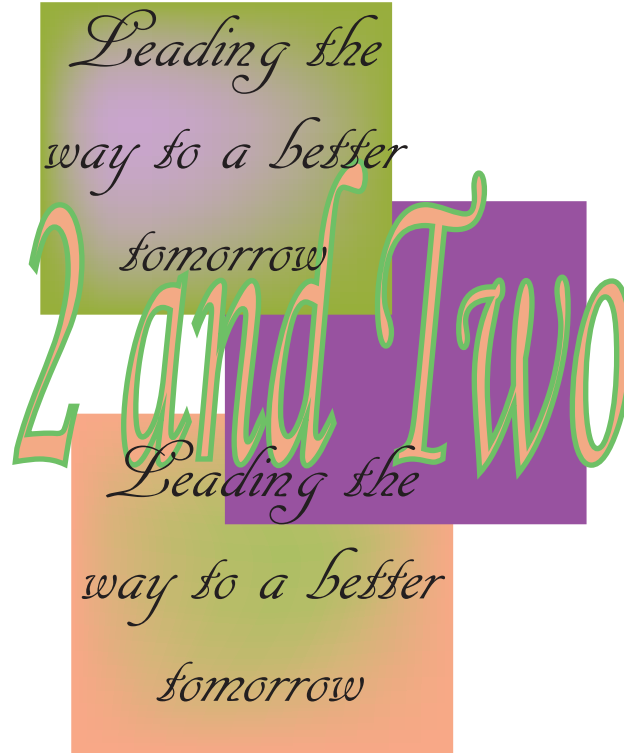


Mission Statement

Eligibility

Must be Medicaid Eligible
Diagnosis of Mental Retardation
Approved Individual Plan of Care
Eligible for ICF/MR I, V, VI or VIII
People with a related condition, deficits in adaptive behavior and Full Scale IQ of 75 or below
People who have a service plan that does not cost more than 125% of the annual ICF/MR

Supported Home Living

Supported Home Living helps individuals living in their own or their families' homes learn, retain, or improve their skills related to activities of daily living. Services include teaching: personal grooming and cleanliness, bed making and household chores, preparing and eating food, and the social and adaptive skills necessary to reside in their own home in the community.

Supportive Employment

Supportive Employment helps sustain paid employment for individuals who, because of their disability, require intensive, ongoing support to perform in a work setting. Services include: adaptations, supervision, and training, related to the individual's diagnosis.

Supervised Living

Supervised Living is for individuals who live in a group home setting. It includes habilitation, supervision, and assistance from service provider staff, if needed, during normal sleeping hours.

Foster Care

Foster Care is provided to individuals of all ages in a home-like environment as an alternative to living in a group home.

Residential Support

Residential Support provides supervision and assistance in a group home setting from service provider staff who remain awake during normal sleeping hours. Most individuals who receive residential support services do so to address medical conditions, maladaptive behaviors, and assistance with activities of daily living.

Day Habilitation

Day Habilitation allows individuals to participate in day habilitation for up to six hours a day, five days a week. Services include: help learning, retaining, and improving self-help and socialization skills and providing the adaptive skills necessary to reside successfully in the community

Respite

Respite provides temporary relief or absence of the unpaid primary caregivers. Respite services can be provided both inside and outside the home.

Nursing

Monitoring health conditions, administering and monitoring medication, providing referrals for medical services, and training individuals, their family members
