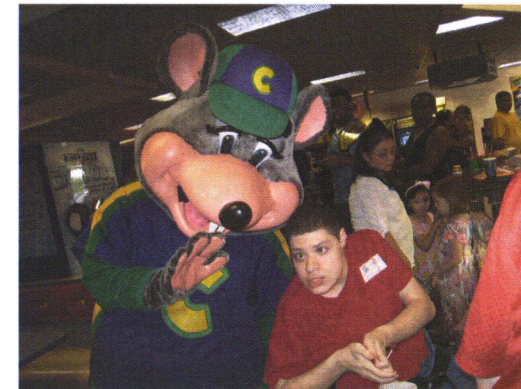

A Little Something Different (“ALSD”) is a family owned HCS and Texas Home Living Provider operated by Paul and Cheryl Chollett. Our mission is to provide quality care and service to individuals with mental retardation or developmental disabilities. We are committed to serve these individuals as if they were our own family members.

Paul and Cheryl Chollett are parents to six children, five biological children and one 11 year old foster child, a little boy with Down’s Syndrome. Paul Chollett, CEO, has 25 years experience in managing people and organizations. Previously he was the President and CEO of American Habilitation Services, a large provider in the State of Texas. Cheryl Chollett, COO, has spent most of her adult life in service of children, focusing on children with special education needs and developmental disabilities. She has 20+ years experience as a special education teacher. Paul and Cheryl, along with their daughter Megan, are a family team that provide hands on, day-to-day management of the program and the individuals served.

Services

Home and Community-Based Services (HCS) Program

The HCS Program provides support services for those with all levels of intellectual disability. Service plans are specific to the individual and client-directed. This means that individuals and their families are integral members and the driving force of the “Team”. Working together, a customized plan of care is designed to meet the unique needs, goals and choices of the individual.

Individuals enrolled in the HCS program have several residential support options available to them. There are small 3 or 4 person group homes with 24 hour awake staff, Foster/companion care, where the individual resides in the home of their provider or supported home living in which the individual lives in their own residence or their family’s residence and in-home support staff come to them and provide care. Whichever support is chosen our dedicated and specially trained support staff work with consumers to attain a nurturing, varied, stimulating and fun environment.

Texas Home Living Program

The Texas Home Living (TxHmL) Program is a limited service program. It was designed especially for people with various levels of intellectual disability who prefer to live in their own or their family's home, but still need some support and services. The cost of services provided in the TxHmL Program is capped at \$ 15,000 and consist of the following:

- Respite
- Day Habilitation
- Personal support in your home
