## Day Programs

### S.T.A.R.S.

Skills Training and Related Services....that's the thrust of the Golden Rule Services day program. Each individual has training goals specific to their needs. Each day has social activities which help build self esteem. Classroom activities help increase academic skills and maintain skills that are already acquired. Arts & craft projects provide a fun activity and also gives each person a sense of worth by making something to give to brighten another person's life.

Each month outings are planned to provide exposure to various activities and places. Excursions to The Sea Center of Texas, in Lake Jackson, Kemah Boardwalk, Galveston Ferry and Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo are examples of outings that provide participants with a day of memories. Other community activities are movies, restaurants, bowling and the library.

The two day program sites — Pearland and Texas City — are busy each day of the week, with people working on individual goals, creating memories and learning to work together.

## The Focus of GRSI

The difference and uniqueness in the approach of GRSI is that instead of focusing on the deficits or 'disabilities' of an individual, we focus on the potential and abilities; instead of dwelling on past failures, we focus on future successes. Emphasis is placed on a person's capabilities rather than his/her limitations.
