Home & Community-based Services (HCS) was created to provide people with disabilities the opportunity to remain in their community as viable citizens. This program enables persons to continue living in their own home under foster care or supported home living or in a small group setting (maximum of 4 people) with others that may need like services.

With over 15 yrs. of experience in Mental Health Services, **Amazing Arc Angels HCS** program provides community services and support to eligible persons as an alternative to the Intermediate Care Facilities for persons within the Mental Retardation (ICF/MR) program.

Mission and Philosophy

Because all individuals are gifts from God, **Amazing Arc Angels HCS** pledges to deliver professional and quality service to each eligible individual. We are dedicated to promoting citizenship within the community, providing access to needed services and creating and maintaining resources to enhance independent living for persons with disabilities.



Who is Eligible for Services?

Adults and children with mental retardation who may have accompanying disabilities that:

- meet the Intermediate Care Facilities for Persons with Mental Retardation (ICF/MR) Level of Care (LOC) 1 criteria,
- are eligible for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or eligible for Medicaid under one of the optional Medicaid groups covered by the MRLA program,
- require services that do not exceed the cost limits set by the state of Texas,
- are not enrolled in another Medicaid waiver program, and
- choose to participate in the HCS program instead of the (ICF/MR) program.

Case Management Services

Once an individual is enrolled in the HCS program they will receive a Case Manager who:

- coordinates the development and implementation of the person's Individual Services Plan (ISP),
- coordinates various aspects of services delivered under the HCS program and through other sources,

- keeps track of the person's progress or lack of progress towards their goals,
- reviews issues related to rights, safety and health.

Services Offered

Based on a team comprised of the disabled individual, Legally Authorized Representative (LAR), Case Manager, a nurse, and other persons chosen by the person or LAR; a plan of services is developed that describe goals and supports the person's needs to ensure the safety, health and welfare of the individual in the community and prevent institutional placement. These services includes, but are not limited to:

- Residential Services
- Foster Care
- Residential Placement
- Day Habilitation
- Nursing
- Adaptive Aids (\$1,000/yr)
- Minor Home Modification
- Dental Treatment (\$1,000/yr)
- Respite (30 dys/yr or 300 hrs/yr)
- Specialized Therapy as needed
- Nursing
