Our homes have been described by family members as “so homely and warm” and our care providers truly care.

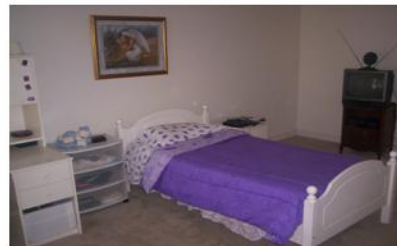

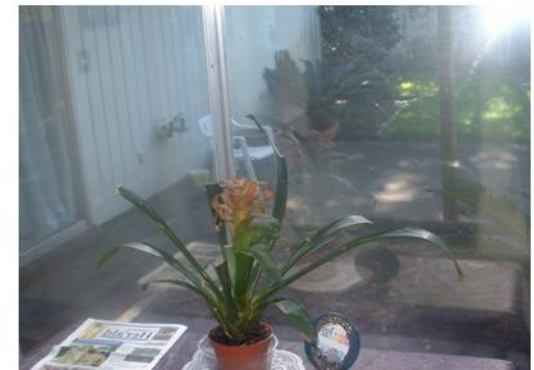

For a person to be eligible for the HCS program, he/she must:

- be eligible for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or be in one of the optional categorical coverage groups as specified in the HCS Waiver Renewal Request 1993-1998;
- be eligible for an ICF/MR I, V, VI level of care;
- have a determination of mental retardation in accordance with state law;
- have an Individual Plan of Care for waiver services which does not exceed state limits and have made a choice of the HCS Program over the ICF-MR Program; and
- not be enrolled in another 1915(c) waiver program.
