Respite Care

Exceptional Care, Inc. offers respite services, designed to provide assistance to both individuals served by the agency and their families, for a brief time period. The duration of respite services may vary from four (4) hours to thirty (30) consecutive days. Respite services may be provided either in the family home, or in a residence operated by Exceptional Health Services.

Assisted Living

Provides low-income housing opportunities under the scope of the Personal Care Facility Licensing Act, Health, and Safety Code, Chapter 247, which furnishes room and board, and one or more Personal Care services to four or more unrelated persons.

Home and Community-Based Services (HCS)

Home and Community Support Services (HCS) components are selected for inclusion in a person's Individual Plan of Care (IPC), to supplement rather than replace the individual's natural support or other supports and services available from non-HCS program sources for which the individual may be eligible. HCS program components are selected based on assessments, which identify specific services and supports necessary for the individuals' health and welfare in the communities, and are necessary to prevent the individuals' admission to institutional services.

Texas Home Living Waiver (TX.HmL)

The Texas Home Living Waiver (Tx HmL) will allow many Texans to remain in their homes and communities, and is a move toward reducing the waiting list for services for persons with Mental Retardation and Related Conditions. (TX HmL) will provide \$10,000 worth of services and supports annually for persons living in their own or family homes. The services include community support, day habilitation, employment assistance, supported employment and respite. Professional and technical supports include skilled nursing, behavioral support, physical and occupational therapy, dietary, speech and language pathology, audiology, minor home modifications, adaptive aids and dental treatment.
