S & E ENTERPRISES HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES PROGRAM

(HCS & TxHml)

The HCS program is designed to assist persons who are mentally challenged in their desire to reach personal goals of independent living.



TEXAS HOME LIVING

The TxHml Program is a Medicaid waiver program approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. It provides community-based services and supports to eligible individuals who live in their own homes or in their family homes.

HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES PROGRAM- HCS

The Home and Community Based Services Program (HCS) provides a comprehensive community based services system for people who are mentally challenged. An Individual Service Plan (ISP) and Individual Plan of Care (IPC) is developed by an Interdisciplinary Team for each individual enrolled in the HCS program based upon individualized assessment and the individual's strengths, needs, and personal goals. The Interdisciplinary Team members.

include the individual who are mentally challenged and/ or legally authorized representative.



The following HCS waiver services are available through S & E Enterprises HCS Program.

- Case management
- Residential assistance (residential support, supported home living, supervised living or foster/companion care)
- Day habilitation
- Supported employment
- Nursing
- Respite (for individual receiving supported home living only)
- Adaptive aids
- Dental
- Minor home modifications
- Consumer Directed Services Agency

Counseling and therapies(speech/ language pathology, occupational therapy, physical therapy, dietary, psychology, audiology, and social work services)

Enrolled individuals receive only those services identified through individualized assessment as required to meet the individual's needs and approved by the Interdisciplinary Team.

Individuals enrolled in the HCS program may choose where and with whom to live, including the option of living with their natural family. Support services may be provided for only a few hours per week for

individuals residing in their own home or with their natural family, or up to 24 hours per day for individuals who require total care and assistance.

To receive HCS services, an individual must be Medicaid eligible and have a diagnosis of mental retardation. Each individual is responsible for payment of his/her living expenses to include rent, food, clothing, and personal items. Assistance is provided to the individual and family in accessing financial resources, such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability, and Food Stamps, in order to meet financial needs.

The HCS Program is designed to support and assist families in meeting the needs of their family members who are mentally challenged. Our HCS program is owned and managed by professionals with experience in the healthcare.
